The London Borough of Camden being satisfied that it is necessary to enable development to be carried out in accordance with permission granted Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 hereby gives notice that it has made an order under Section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended) entitled The Stopping Up of Highways (London Borough of Camden) (Number 1) Order 2023 ("the Order") to authorise the stopping up of the highways described in the First Schedule.

The Order has been made in order to enable the development described in the Second Schedule to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission, granted by the London Borough of Camden on the 18th June 2014 under reference 2013/5947/P, as amended by planning applications granted under reference 2015/3151/P, 2016/0936/P, 2017/0363/P, 2017/01518/P, 2021/5384/P, 2022/0929/P and 2022/1603/P and for no other purpose.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and who wishes to question its validity on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, or that any relevant requirements have not been complied with in relation to the Order, may apply to the High Court within 6 weeks of **17**th **August 2023**, for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any of its provisions.

The Greenwood Centre, Greenwood Place & Highgate Day Centre, 19-37 Highgate Road London NW5

The Development

Demolition of existing buildings and redevelopment to provide: a new 3,228sqm (GIA) Centre for Independent Living (CIL) (Class D1) comprising 3 storeys plus basement at Greenwood Place; a part 5 part 7 storey mixed-use development at Highgate Road comprising 42 residential units (including 8 supported affordable housing units) and 100sqm (GIA) social enterprise in flexible retail, restaurant/café, office or community use (Classes A1/A3/B1/D1) at ground floor level; highway improvements to Greenwood Place, and associated plant, landscaping, servicing and disabled car parking.
