Pedestrian Flows

- i. The footways along the Torrington Place / Tavistock Place corridor are congested at points throughout the day and there are locations where the footways are narrow or with 'street furniture' on them, which reduces the overall width available for people to walk. This report includes details of surveys that were commissioned to record the number of pedestrians in 2015, 2016 and 2018. It should be noted that the surveys undertaken in 2015 were prior to the removal of the westbound motor vehicle traffic lane and the introduction of the two, one-way cycle lanes.
- ii. Video surveys were undertaken in 2015, 2016 and 2018 to record the number of pedestrians using the corridor. Five locations along the corridor were surveyed where data has been used to show the number of pedestrians along the corridor during the morning peak hour, evening peak hour and between 7am and 7pm (daily flow).

- iii. Table 1 gives a snapshot of pedestrian flows along the corridor in 2015, in 2016 and in 2018.
- iv. It can be seen from Table 1 that pedestrian flows along the corridor are high (averaging more than 1,000 pedestrians per hour in the morning and evening peaks) and that they have remained broadly the same in recent years (averaging the total flows for all of the sites shows that 2018 flows were 0.2% lower than 2015 flows).
- v. Table 1 also shows that the pedestrian flows are highest towards the western end of the corridor (18,756 on both sides of the corridor at Byng Place). The four sites on the eastern end are between 32% and 57% lower than the pedestrian flows at Byng Place towards the west.

vi. There have been small decreases in the number of pedestrians at Byng Place and Tavistock Square, west of Woburn Place in 2018 (3% and 5% fewer pedestrians than in 2015 respectively). There have also been some increases in the number of pedestrians in 2018 at three sites along Tavistock Place (east of Woburn Place, west of Marchmont Street and east of Marchmont Street) where the data suggests that there were 1%, 2% and 8% more pedestrians than in 2015 respectively.
