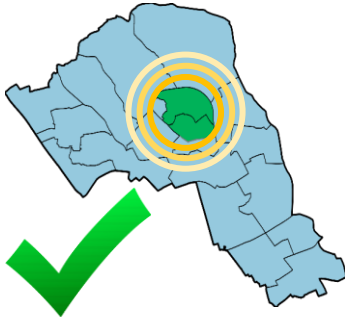




What you told us about our plans for Kentish Town

You said that the local area must be able to support any increase in numbers of people living, working and visiting there



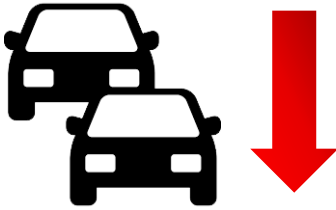
Housing

You want a large number of new homes to be affordable and social

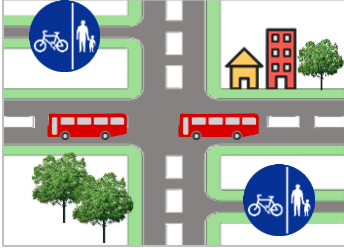


You also want priority for new homes to be given to local people, key workers and Londoners

You said that what would help the area most are more opportunities for young people

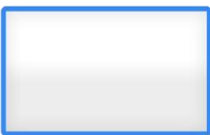


You want

You said the businesses in the new neighbourhood should not compete with the high street

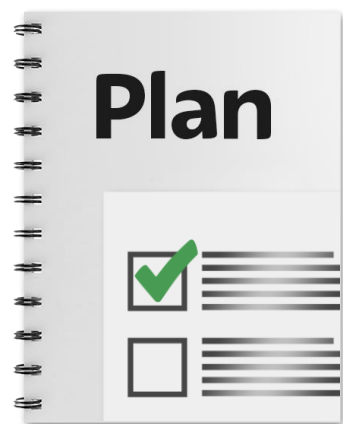
Health and wellbeing

You would like the area to be greener and to have safe green open spaces



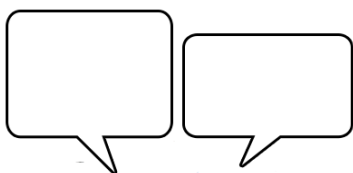
You want us to work towards having the best air quality and less traffic pollution
