

Camden Family Changemakers Evaluation: Information Sheet

What is the Camden Family Changemakers Evaluation?

Becca (Camden Family Early Help) asked Lizzie (UCL's [Co-Production Collective](#)) and Alice and Hafsa (Camden Community Researchers, residents and parents) to evaluate the Camden Family Changemakers project. We will be exploring the experiences of the Expert Parents and other participants in order to:

- identify where we could improve in future
- understand what was valuable about this project
- gather learning to share with others looking to do similar work across Camden and beyond

We're especially interested in understanding 'what's changed' as a result of the project, for the Expert Parents and more broadly.

Why am I being asked to take part?

You were part of the Family Changemakers project in some way, so we want to hear how it was for you.

What will taking part involve?

We will ask you to sign a consent form to say you're happy to participate, then ask you some questions about your experiences and perceptions of the Family Changemakers project. This might take the form of an online survey, a phone call, a group discussion or something else – we'll work together to find the method which works best for you.

What is the benefit of me taking part?

We hope that taking part will offer you a chance to reflect on your experiences as part of this project, continue your involvement with the group and help us develop work like this in future.

What will happen to anything I share?

Any notes or recordings will be securely stored within Camden Council, according to GDPR and data protection policies. They will only be accessed by the team involved in this project.

We may use quotes from you to illustrate our findings in a report or other publication, but only where they do not disclose your identity. Any information or opinions you share will be anonymised and we will not ask for any personal, sensitive or confidential information.

Once this project is completed, the data will be deleted within 30 days.

Do I have to take part?

No, participating in this evaluation is completely optional. We will not share whether or not you participated with anyone else. You can also withdraw your consent at any point throughout the project or afterwards.

What will happen as a result of this evaluation?

We will publish a report or similar publication to share our learning. We will make this available publicly, via the Camden website. We hope that this evaluation will be used to support others in Camden and beyond to take on similar projects and ways of working.
